That I, Donald E. Baltz, in consideration of the sum of Twenty-four Thousand (\$24,000.00) in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William J. Kelly, Jr.

All that lot of land situate on the southwest side of Carolina Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 36 on plat of Section A, of Gower Estates, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, January 1960, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in plat book QQ, pages 146 and 147, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwest side of Carolina Avenue, at joint front corner of Lots 35 and 36, and runs thence with the line of lot 35, S. 43-34 W. 153.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-20 W. 135 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 37, N. 60-51 E. 169.4 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of Carolina Avenue; thence with the curve of Carolina Avenue (the chord being S. 47-57 E. 66 feet) to an iron pin; thence still along Carolina Avenue, S. 65-21 E. 18.9 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same lot conveyed to grantor by Conyers & Gower, Inc. by deed recorded October 6, 1961 in deed volume 683 page 429 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., and is conveyed subject to restrictions applicable to said subdivision recorded in deed book 663 page 118.
