

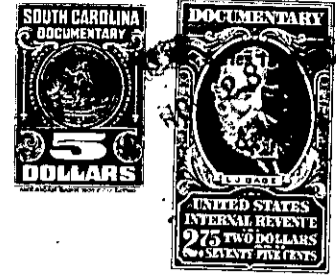

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the northern side of Reids School Road shown as Lot No. 2
