1. KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Lillie A. Nash, Grantor, in consideration of \$ 74.00 , paid by Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission, a body politic under the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Grantee, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey unto the said grantee a right of way in and over my tract of land situate in the above State and County and deed to which is recorded in the Office of the R. M. C., of said State and County in Book 173 at page 24 and encroaching on my land a distance of 74 feet, more or less, and being that portion of my said land forty (40) feet wide during construction and twenty-five (25) feet wide thereafter, as same has been marked out on the plat in the R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "XX", pages 58-63.

The Grantor herein by these presents warrants that there are no liens, mortgages or other encumbrances to a clear title to these lands and that she is legally qualified and entitled to grant a right of way with respect to the lands described herein.

2. The right of way is to and does convey to the grantee, its successors and assigns, the following: The right and privilege of entering the aforesaid strip of land and to construct, maintain and operate within the limits of same, pipe lines, manholes and any other adjuncts deemed by the grantee to be necessary for the purpose of conveying sanitary sewage and industrial wastes, and to make such relocations, changes, renewals, substitutions, replacements and additions of or to the same from time to time as said grantee may deem desirable; the right at all times to cut away and keep clear of said pipe lines any and all vegetation that might, in the opinion of the grantee, endanger or injure the pipe lines or their appurtenances, or interfere with
