(3) Also, the further right, privilege and easement to take and use water jointly with James Bailey Pittman and Mildred C. Pittman from said well in an amount adequate and sufficient for the use of the grantee's farmstead and dwelling.

It is understood and agreed that said right-of-way will run from the location of the well to the house located on the property of Harold N. Pittman and Joyce Pittman.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said easement and right-of-way unto Harold N. Pittman and Joyce Pittman, their heirs and assigns forever.
