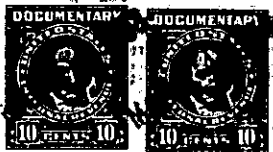

in consideration of the sum of Twelve Thousand and No/100ths (\$12,000.00)-----

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto DAVID L. HELMANTOLER AND CHRISTINE P. HELMANTOLER:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northern side of Sharon Drive near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 53 as shown on a plat prepared by C.C. Jones, Surveyor, dated December, 1962, entitled "Extension of Sharon Park", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book CCC at page 71, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Sharon Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 52 and 53, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 52 N. 27-00 W. 176 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly of Wade; thence with the line of the said Wade property N. 63-06 E. 80 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 53 and 54; thence with the line of Lot No. 54 S. 27-00 E. 175.7 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Sharon Drive; thence with the Northern side of Sharon Drive S. 63-00 W. 80 feet to the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Henry C. Harding, dated January 2, 1963, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 717 at page 377.
