KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, WILLIAM A. YEARGIN, of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, have made, constituted, and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute, and appoint, HELEN YEARGIN MARSHALL, of the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name, place, and stead, and for my use, to ask, demand, sue for, collect, and receive all such sums of money which are or shall be due, owing, payable, and belonging to me or detained from me, in any manner whatsoever, by any person or persons whatsoever, specifically to sell or otherwise dispose of the 11 hogs as set forth in item 2 of the Inventory and Appraisement of the personal property of the above entitled estate.

Giving and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority in and about the premises; and to use all due means, course and process in the law for the full, effectual, and complete execution thereof, and in my name to make, execute and deliver all and every instrument in writing under seal, or otherwise, and for the premises to appear and my person to represent before any Governor, Judge, officer, and minister of the law whatsoever, and in any court or courts of judicature, and on my behalf, to prosecute
