KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we ELIA DORROH WITHERS and CHARLES DUDLEY WITHERS,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

by LAND, INC., its successors and assigns,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said LAND, INC., its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate at the Southeast corner of the intersection of East Washington Street and Heldman Street, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, and having the following metes

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southeast corner of the intersection of East Washington Street and Heldman Street, and runs thence along the East side of Heldman Street, S. 18-1/2 W., 165 feet to an iron pin on the North edge of a 10-foot alley; thence along the North edge of said alley, S. 69-1/4 E., 54 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 18-1/2 E., 165 feet to an iron pin on the South side of East Washington Street; thence with East Washington Street, N. 69-1/4 W.,

This is the same property conveyed to Erin Sanders Dorroh by deed of W. R. Sewell, dated February 9, 1912, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 10, at Page 151. Thereafter, Erin Sanders Dorroh died testate and by her will, which is on file in the Probate Court for Greenville County, S. C., in Apartment 530, File 21, she devised the above described property to her daughter, the grantor Ella Dorroh Withers, for her life with the remainder in fee to the grantor, Charles Dudley Withers, her grandson.
