BEGINNING at a stake on the northern side of Jolly Avenue, at the corner of Lot No. 59, and running thence with the line of said lot N. 21-13 W. 170.6 feet to a stake; thence S. 70-42 W. 90.1 feet to stake at corner of Lot No. 57; thence with the line of said lot, S. 21-13 E. 173.4 feet to a stake on Jolly Avenue; thence with the northern side of said Avenue, N. 68-47 E. 90 feet to the beginning corner.
