

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that

I, Grady E. Tripp, of Greenville County,

Twenty-Six Thousand, Nine Hundred and No/100-----(\$ 26,900.00)---- Dollars, in consideration of the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and released unto Earl A. Young and Dolores S. Young, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 11 of a subdivision known as "ADDITION TO WILDAIRE ESTATES", according to a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service November 1962, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book RR, at Page 100, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Ramblewood Drive, the joint front corner of Lots #11 and #12, and running thence along the line of these lots, S. 86-39 E. 177.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 7-34 E. 95.0 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 41-52 W. 70.0 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots #11 and #10; running thence N. 71-03 W. 181.6 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Ramblewood Drive; thence along the eastern edge of Ramblewood Drive, which line is curved, the chord of which is N. 11-41 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by W. N. Leslie. Inc. by deed dated April 11, 1963, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 720, at Page 465.
