RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 15TH day of AUGUST, 1913,
by and between THOMAS S. BRUCE,

hereinafter called "Grantor" (whether one or more), and DUKE POWER COMPANY, a New Jersey Corporation, hereinafter called "Grantee";

WITNESSETH:

That Grantor, in consideration of \$ 5000⁰⁰ paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, the right to erect, construct, reconstruct, replace, maintain and use towers, poles, wires, lines, cables, and all necessary and proper foundations, footings, crossarms and other appliances and fixtures for the purpose of transmitting electric power and for Grantee's communication purposes, together with a right of way, on, along and in all of the hereinafter described tract(s) of land lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Being a strip of land 150 feet wide extending 75 feet on each side of a surveyed line which has been marked on the ground and extends from a point in the northwesterly line of the Frances T. Tindal, et al. property, said point being N 27-16 E 309.6 ft. from the southeasterly corner of said property, and running thence N 36-54 W 223.8 feet; thence S 85-26 W 29.0 ft. to a point in the southerly line of the Helen B. Black, et al. property.
