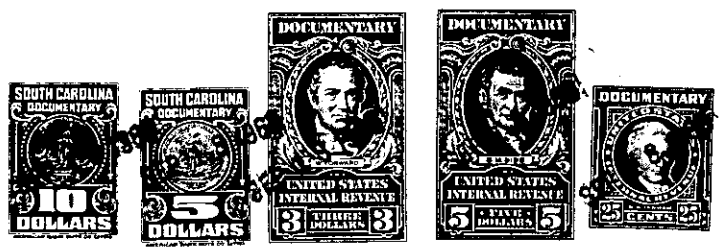
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That **GEORGE T. JOHNSON AND MILDRED M. JOHNSON**
