

Deed for South Carolina

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, PHILIP N. BROWNSTEIN, of Washington, D.C., successor in office to Neal J. Hardy as Federal Housing Commissioner, Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto JULIA S. MINTON

Grantee(s), and to the heirs and assigns of said Grantee(s),

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the southerly side of Paris Mountain Avenue, near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 32 on plat of Property of Ethel Y. Perry Estate as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat B, page 33, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the southerly edge of a 5 foot sidewalk running along Paris Mountain Avenue, joint front corner of Lots 32 and 33, and running thence S 6-02 E 110 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 32 and 33; thence S 83-58 W 60 feet; thence N 6-02 W 110 feet to an iron pin on the southerly side of sidewalk, joint front corner of Lots 31 and 32; thence along the southerly side of said sidewalk N 83-58 E 60 feet to the point of beginning.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining or incident.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Grantee(s), and to the heirs and assigns of said Grantee(s) forever.

SUBJECT to all covenants, restrictions, reservations, easements, conditions and rights appearing of record; and SUBJECT to any state of facts an accurate survey would show.

AND THE SAID GRANTOR covenants that he has not made, done, committed, executed or suffered any act or acts, thing or things whatsoever, whereby or by means whereof, the above mentioned and described premises, or any part or parcel thereof, now are, or at any time hereafter shall or may be impeached, charged or encumbered in any manner or way whatsoever.

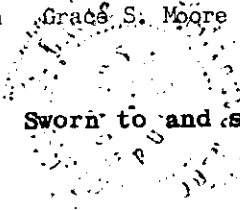
