That the general nature of the business which it proposes to do is to buy, sell, import, rt, trade and deal in automotive accessories, supplies and equipexport, trade and deal in automotive accessories, supplies and equipment of every type and description at wholesale and retail, or otherment of every type and description at wholesale and retail, or otherwise, used in connection with the use, adornment, repair, rebuilding, operation and maintenance of automobiles, trucks and other vehicles and conveyances manufactured within or without the United States.

To buy, sell, import, export, distribute, exchange, trade and deal in, and to maintain, assemble, install, equip, repair, hold, own, use or otherwise deal in motor parts, accessories, contrivances, devices, machinery and equipment of every type and description, at wholesale and retail, for automobiles, trucks and other vehicles manufactured outside of the United States, and to conduct generally an axle, brake, gear, transmission, parts, accessory and automobile business in all its branches, as distributor, dealer, broker, importer, agent or otherwise.

To do all acts necessary or incidental to carrying out the purposes set forth above. set forth above.

In general, to carry on any other business in connection with the foregoing, whether manufacturing or otherwise, and to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of South Carolina upon corporations formed under the act hereinafter referred to, and to do any or all of the things hereinbefore set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do.
