All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the eastern side of Mayflower Avenue, and being shown and designated as Lot no. 9 of Pecan Terrace as shown on a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service dated March 27, 1953, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "GG" at page 9, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:
