the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release James V. Patterson, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being at the southeasterly corner of the intersection of Buena Vista Street and Karen Drive, being known and designated as the greater portion of Lot 112 and a small triangular strip of Lot 111 of a subdivision known as University Heights according to a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service January, 1949, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB at Page 21 and a revised plat of Lots 111 and 112 prepared by R. K.
