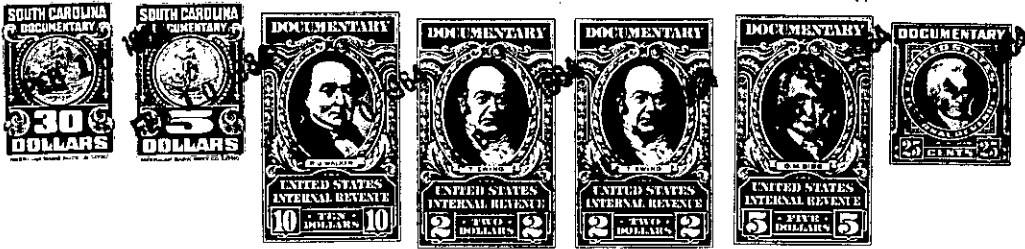
That We, H. J. Martin and Joe O. Charping
