R.M.C. **RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT**

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 11th day of February, 1964,
by and between **ESSIE MAE WEEKS**

hereinafter called "Grantor" (whether one or more), and DUKE POWER COMPANY, a New Jersey corporation, hereinafter called "Grantee";

WITNESSETH:

That Grantor, in consideration of \$ 992.25 paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, the right to erect, construct, reconstruct, replace, maintain and use towers, poles, wires, lines, cables, and all necessary and proper foundations, footings, crossarms and other appliances and fixtures for the purpose of transmitting electric power and for Grantee's communication purposes, together with a right of way, on, along and in all of the hereinafter described tract(s) of land lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

FIRST PARCEL:

BEGINNING at the southeasterly corner of the property of the Grantor and runs thence with the northerly line of the J. G. and Thomas Cothran property N 74-22 W 1333.4 ft. to the southeasterly corner of the William O. Fisher property; thence with the easterly line of said property N 5-28 E 27.0 ft.; thence S 74-31 E 1336.4 ft.; thence S 12-14 W 30.1 ft. to the BEGINNING.

SECOND PARCEL:

BEGINNING at the southwesterly corner of the property of the Grantor and runs thence with the easterly line of the Robert H. Hoiliday property N 14-49 E 26.2 ft.; thence S 74-31 E 645.1 ft. to a point in the westerly line of the William O. Fisher property; thence with the westerly line of said property S 2-07 W 27.2 ft.; to a point in the northerly line of the J. G. and Thomas Cothran property; thence with the northerly line of said property three courses and distances as follows: (1) N 74-29 W 96.3 ft.; (2) N 74-31 W 299.8 ft.; and (3) N 74-28 W 257.9 ft. to the BEGINNING.
