All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon lying and being on the southwesterly side of Williamsburg Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being known and designated as Lot No. 48 on plat of Belle Meade, as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book EE, pages 116 and 117, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwesterly side of Williamsburg Drive, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots 34 and 48 and running thence along the common line of said lots N 78-11 W 86.2 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 34, 35 and 48; thence N 3-42 W 112.6 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 47 and 48; thence along the common line of said lots S 78-27 E 115.9 feet to an iron pin on the southwesterly side of Williamsburg Drive; thence with the southwesterly side of said Drive S 11-33 W 109 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
