All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 64 of Pecan Terrace, Section No. 2, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "EE", at Page 108 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

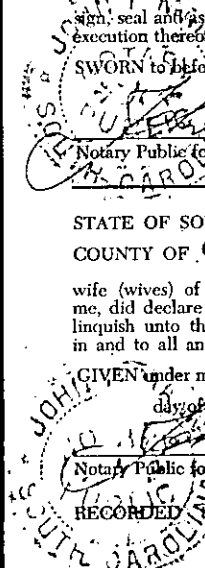
