

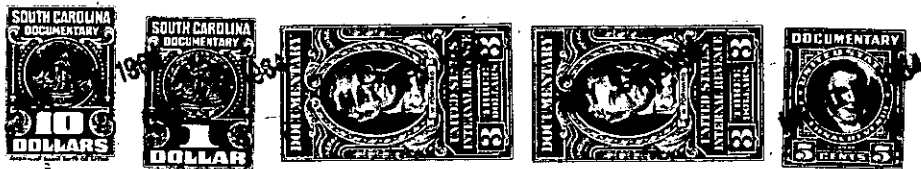

ALL that lot of land, situate on the East side of Parkins Mill Road, and on the South side of Stonehaven Drive, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 10, on plat of Section C of Gower Estates, made by R. K. Campbell and Webb Surveying & Mapping Co., July 27, 1964, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book YY, Page 113, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Parkins Mill Road at joint front corner of Lots 10 and 11, and runs thence with the line of Lot 11, N. 74-26 E., 250 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 15-34 W., 198.6 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Stonehaven Drive; thence along Stonehaven Drive, S. 62-26 W., 230.6 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Stonehaven Drive and Parkins Mill Road (the chord being S. 23-26 W., 38.8 feet) to an iron pin on Parkins Mill Road; thence along Parkins Mill Road, S. 15-34 E., 125 feet to the beginning corner.
