Flynn in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and No/100 (\$200.00) DOLLARS, and assumption of the mortgage referred to below to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FRANCIS V. BROTHERS AND ANN K. BROTHERS, THEIR HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, FOREVER:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the Southwest side of Pinehurst Drive, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot 31 on plat of Section B of Pinehurst Subdivision made by W. N. Willis, Engineer, October 28, 1948, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book S, Page 77, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Pinehurst Drive at joint front corner of Lots 29 and 31 and running thence with the line of Lot 29, S. 62-23 W., 135.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 27-37 E., 60 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 33, N. 62-23 E., 134.7 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Pinehurst Drive; thence along Pinehurst Drive, N. 26-48 W., 60 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to us by deed of William A. Parton, dated February 15, 1964, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 742, Page 338.

The grantees assume and agree to pay that mortgage given by William A. Parton to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., dated January 29, 1962, in the original amount of \$11,000.00, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Mortgage Book 880, Page 371, on which there remains unpaid a principal balance of \$ 10,488.91.

Grantees to pay 1964 taxes.

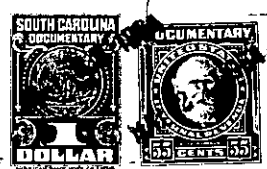
TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
