to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

EDWARD OGLESBY, His Heirs and Assigns Forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being at the Northern intersection of Pine Creek Drive and Marlboro Drive, in Gantt Township, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 270 as shown on a plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated March 28, 1956, entitled "Plat of Belle Meade, Section 3", and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG at page 187, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Pine Creek Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 270 and 271, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 271 N. 38-30 E. 105 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 289 S. 65-48 E. 89.3 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Marlboro Drive; thence with the Western side of Marlboro Drive S. 13-36 W. 67.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the Western side of Marlboro Drive, S. 17-30 W. 46.1 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Pine Creek Drive and Marlboro Drive, the chord of which is S. 72-53 W. 28.3 feet to an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Pine Creek Drive; thence with the Northeastern side of Pine Creek Drive, N. 51-30 W. 116.1 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to the grantor herein by Deed of Gerald C. Twitty, dated July 24, 1959, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 630 at page 332.

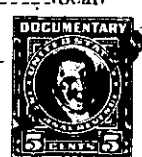
