consideration of the sum of hree Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-five and 34/100ths (\$3725.34)----- DOLLARS, and assumption of mortgage indebtedness recited below to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto DUNBAR CORPORATION, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the Western side of Sumner Street, in the City of Greenville, being a portion of Lots 2 and 4 of Block a, as shown on Plat recorded in Plat Book A, at pages 122 and 123, and also being shown as Lot 9, Section 3, page 77, of the City Block Book, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Western side of Sumner Street 150 feet North from the corner of Arlington Avenue and Sumner Street and running thence with the line of Sumner Street, N. 17 E. 50 feet, more or less, to an iron pin, at the corner of a lot now or formerly owned by T.
