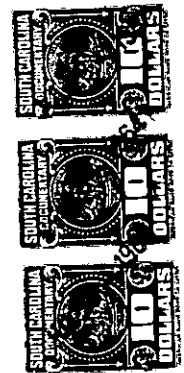

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Boro Tape Company, Inc., formerly Westboro Weaving Company, a New York corporation, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of New York and having a principal place of business at New York City, State of New York, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Westboro Weaving Company, Inc., formerly Stevenson Weaving Co., Inc., its successors and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land with the improvements thereon situate in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and shown as Parcel No. 1 on map made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, October 1934 and of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H at Pages 259 and 260 and having according to said map the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the south side of the right of way of C. & W. C. R. R., which point is 575 feet from the center line of the old paving on Laurens Road as the same was located in October 1934, (said paving having since been increased in width by addition to the north side thereof) and which point is 532.4 feet measuring along the southern line of the right of way of C. & W. C. R. R. from a point in said line of the right of way and 1 foot north or northeast of the north or northeast line of the present sidewalk pavement of said Laurens Road; thence S. 18-0 E. 240 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 72-0 E. 500 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 18-0 W. 147.4 feet to an iron pipe on the south side of the said right of way; thence in a westerly direction along the line of said right of way to the beginning corner.
