Know All Men by These Presents:

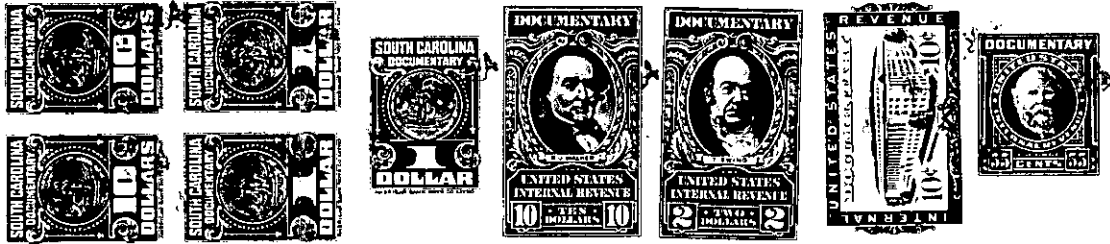

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. Lynell Sumner, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot # 16 on Shamrock Acres, plat of which is recorded in Plat Book "YY" at page 43, and, according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Shamrock Circle at joint front corner of Lots # 15 and 16 and running thence with the line of said lots, N. 81-57 E., 168.3 feet; thence S. 9-21 E., 323.7 feet; thence N. 32-50 W., 328 feet to an iron pin on Shamrock Circle; thence with Shamrock Circle, N. 28-10 E., 43 feet to bend; thence continuing with Shamrock Circle, N. 8-03 W., 32.2 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to the easements and set-back line as shown on said plat and to the recorded restrictions applicable to Shamrock acres.
