All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 25 of a subdivision known as Stone Lake Heights, Section III, as shown on a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, October 1, 1958, revised May 26, 1961, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at Page 96, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern edge of Stone Lake Drive, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 25 and 26, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, following a 10-foot drainage easement for most of the distance, S. 31-19 W. 200.3 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot No. 24; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 24 and 25, following a 10-foot drainage easement for a portion of the distance, S. 58-40 E. 110.0 feet to an iron pin on the western edge of Stono Drive; thence along the western edge of Stono Drive, N. 36-30 E. 189.2 feet to an iron pin; thence following the curvature of Stono Drive as it intersects with Stone Lake Drive, the chord being N. 14-01 W. 31.8 feet, to an iron pin on the southern edge of Stone Lake Drive; thence along the southern edge of Stone Lake Drive, N. 64-31 W. 105.0 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is subject to recorded easements and rights-of-way for the installation and maintenance of public utilities and to drainage easements as shown on the recorded plat; and there is also imposed upon the above described lot restrictions and protective covenants identical to those recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 632, at page 41.
