Dargan are owners of land abutting upon said Jones Gap Road, and have brought suit against certain other abutting landowners to enforce their right to use said road for purposes of ingress and egress to their lands, and the undersigned, also abutting landowners, have agreed with said Ware and Dargan to abide by the outcome of said suit, and

WHEREAS, said suit has been settled out of court by the signing by the other abutting landowners, of an agreement similar to these presents, and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the said prior agreement and the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar paid by the said Henry L. Ware and E. E. Dargan to the undersigned, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, on behalf of themselves, their heirs, assigns, and successors in title, hereby recognize the existence of the right of the said Henry L. Ware and E. E. Dargan, their heirs, assigns, and successors in title, as owners of property abutting on said Jones Gap Road, to freely use and maintain for use the same for ingress and egress to their lands at any and all times free from hindrance and obstruction.
