

Thereafter, Temperance W. (Scott) McKittrick died testate on January 29, 1953, and by her Will which is on file in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 617, File 18, she devised her property to her daughters, Mary McKittrick Knight and Sue McKittrick McKelvey, and to her grandson, the grantee herein, Samuel L. McKittrick, and named the said Mary McKittrick Knight and Sue McKittrick McKelvey as Executrices giving them full power to sell and convey any property owned by her. Sue McKittrick McKelvey subsequently died testate and by her Will which is on file in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 624, File 40, she devised her interest in this property to her husband, Hugh Caryl McKelvey, Jr. and named him as her Executor, giving him individually and as Executor the power to sell and dispose of any property which she owned at the time of her death.
