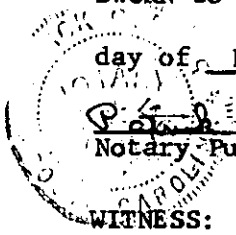

Woodruff; that he knows of his own knowledge that at the time the said Dr. Frank B. Woodruff executed his will on July 9, 1955, he was the owner of a lot located on the Southeast side of North Main Street in the Town of Greer on which was located a house in which he, at that time, resided and an apartment building, said property having been acquired by Dr. Frank B. Woodruff by deeds from R. L. Stuart Jr. and Maida Westmoreland, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 378, Page 309, and in Deed Book 378, Page 279, and further knows of his own knowledge that in Item Three of the will of the said Dr. Frank B. Woodruff under which he devises his house and apartment in Greer, South Carolina, to his wife, Martha C. Woodruff, was the property on the Southeast side of North Main Street in Greer, South Carolina, which was acquired by the Testator under deeds of R. L. Stuart Jr. and Maida Westmoreland referred to above.
