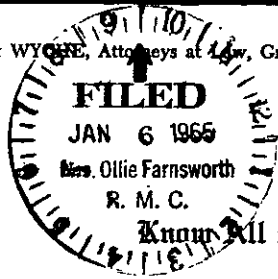


STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, GREENVILLE COUNTY



That I, R. E. Cox, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand & no/100 (\$3,000.00) - - - - - DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said SLOAN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC.

ALL that tract of land situate on the southwest side of a county road near Lakeside in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing ten (10) acres, more or less, known and designated as Tract No. 3 on a plat of the property of C. C. Good, recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book L, at page 77, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest edge of said county road at the joint front corner of Tracts 2 and 3, and running thence along the line of Tract 2, S. 12-45 W. 1165 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence N. 46-30 W. 620 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 32-30 E. 1200 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern edge of said county road; thence with the southwestern edge of said road, S. 12-15 E. 300 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to me by deed of J. A. Drake, dated March 27, 1964, and recorded March 30, 1964, in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 745, Page 340.

This conveyance is subject to a lease dated on or about February 15, 1964, for one (1) year, between J. A. Drake with Dickerson, Inc., as Tenant, which is recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 744, Page 411, said lease being for one year only with no renewal option, said lease and rentals payable thereunder is assigned herewith to grantee.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and its successors and Assigns forever.

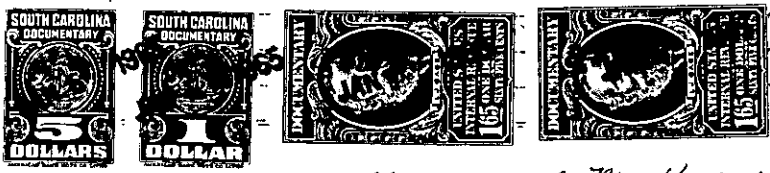
