

- 13. All promotional and identification materials used in connection with the downtown parking plan must meet with the approval of the Corporation's Board of Directors as to color, size, design, etc.
- 14. It shall be the privilege of either party to the contract to re-open negotiations relating to the price of stamps to be charged at the wholesale or retail level. It shall also be the privilege of either party to the contract to require a certified audit of the financial records of the party making the request, said audit to be made available prior to any negotiation.
- 15. It shall be within the power of the membership of the Parking Plan to recommend improvements for parking lots participating in the downtown parking plan. It shall also be within the power of the Board of Directors to expell from participation any parking lot which does not meet what is considered to be minimum standards agreed upon or any "retail" participant who refuses to abide by the regulations as applied to parking stamp distribution.
- 16. An initiation fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be charged each charter member and for each parking lot participating in the downtown parking plan. Any firm or individual joining the parking plan after an elapse of ninety (90) days from the date of formal institution of the plan shall be charged an initiation fee of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.
- 17. The name of the plan shall be "Downtown Greenville Park & Shop, Inc."

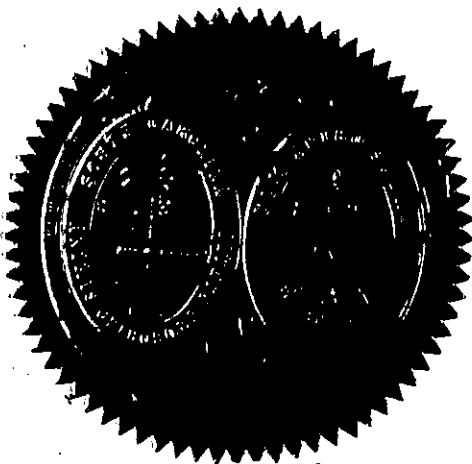
