All of my right, title and interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the eastern side of Spring Street (formerly Frohawk Street) in the City of Greer, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being presently shown and designated in the Greenville County Auditor's Office on Tax Map G-14, Block 3, as Lot 40, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the eastern side of Spring Street (formerly Frohawk Street) approximately 361 feet from Emma Street, and at the joint front corner of property now or formerly owned by Charles Littlefield, and running thence east with the Littlefield line 209 feet to an iron pin; thence in a northerly direction with line of property now or formerly owned by Hawkins 80 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence west with a fence 209 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Spring Street; thence south with said Street 59 feet to the beginning point, being the same property conveyed to Belton Prince by deed of Chas. Eva Prince died intestate in September, 1958, as appears in the records of the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apt. 744, File 24, leaving as her sole heirs at law her four children, namely, William Prince, Annie Mae Mayfield, Marie P. Anderson and Johnny Prince, who, together with Harnetha Davis, the widow of Nathaniel Prince, are the present owners of the above described property.
