8. The general nature of the business for which the corporation is organized is (it is not necessary to set forth in the purposes powers enumerated in Section 2.2) (12—12.2 Supplemental Code

1962) to engage in the purchasing, selling, or distributing, as principal or agent, of all kinds of heating, air conditioning, coding, or insulating equipment, machinery, or apparatus, together with related types of equipment and accessories or repair parts for the same, and to act as a general distributor for such equipment.
