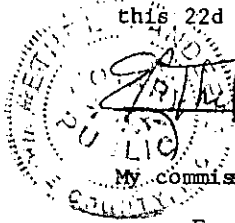

H. T. Buchanan, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that he is an Assistant Treasurer of Carolina Power & Light Company, a North Carolina public service corporation, the Grantor in a deed and bill of sale executed by said Company to Duke Power Company, dated February 22, 1965, to which this affidavit is attached; and that he is familiar with the property conveyed by said deed and bill of sale and the consideration paid therefor by the Grantee, as disclosed by the books and records of Carolina Power & Light Company.

Affiant further deposes and says that by the above mentioned deed and bill of sale personalty and realty have been conveyed; that the consideration of \$435,006.88 recited in said instrument includes lands and other realty in South Carolina which are valued on the books of Carolina Power & Light Company at \$71,093.00, which amount actually exceeds the consideration received by Carolina Power & Light Company for such South Carolina lands and other realty in the aforesaid conveyance to Duke Power Company; and that the stated consideration in excess of \$71,093.00 represents consideration for personalty.
