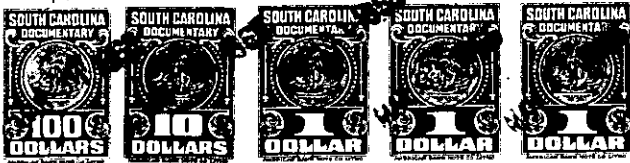

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by John K. Earle, Jr., Wm. H. Earle and David F. Earle

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by  
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John K. Earle, Jr.,  
Wm. H. Earle and David F. Earle, Their Heirs and Assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in \_\_\_\_\_ Township,  
County, State of South Carolina

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in  
Grove Township, County and State aforesaid, and being a part of the  
home tract of the late Samuel Campbell, deceased, and known as Tract  
No. 1 and 2 on plat made by John M. Cureton on March 8, 1863 in the  
division of the lands of Samuel Campbell, deceased, and containing  
87 acres, more or less.

ALSO: All that piece, parcel or tract of land containing 7 1/4 acres,  
more or less, situate, lying and being in Grove Township, State  
and County aforesaid, situate on the South side of creek waters of  
Reedy Fork Creek and Reedy River and being the same property conveyed  
to the late John H. Rainey by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated the 13th  
day of January, 1937, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in deed volume 183 at page 186.

ALSO: All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Grove Township,  
State and County aforesaid, known as the Old Campbell Place,  
located about one mile East from the Augusta Road, four miles from  
Piedmont, on branch waters of Grove Creek, and containing 98.35 acres,  
more or less. Less, however, 94/100 acres which was set aside for a  
family cemetery. This being the same property conveyed to J. H.  
Rainey by deed from Theodore Henderson dated January 10, 1935 and deed  
from S. J. Yeargin, et al by deed dated December 27, 1935.

ALSO: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, State  
and County aforesaid, on the South side of the road leading from  
Piedmont to Sandy Springs Church, containing 20.80 acres, more or less,  
and being the same property conveyed to J. H. Rainey by Horace Fuller  
by deed dated the 12th day of September, 1938.
