7. If any trees or shrubs situated in any lot shall by their roots or branches become detrimental to adjacent lots or avenues, or unsightly or inconvenient to passengers, it shall be the duty of the Directors, or their agents, and they shall have the right to enter the said lot and remove the said trees and shrubs, or such parts thereof as they shall determine to be detrimental, unsightly or inconvenient.

8. If any monument, effigy or any structure whatever or any inscription be placed in or upon any lot which shall be determined by the Directors to be offensive or improper, or injurious to the appearance of surrounding lots or grounds, they shall have the right, and it shall be their duty, to enter upon such lot and remove the said offensive or improper object.

9. No sign indicating that a lot or vault is "For Sale" will be permitted in the grounds.

10. The Directors, from time to time, may lay out or alter such avenues or walks, or make such rules and regulations for the government of the ground as they may deem requisite or proper to promote the general objects of the Cemetery.

11. The proprietors of the lots and their families will be allowed access to the grounds at all reasonable times, observing the rules which are or may be adopted for the regulation of visitors.

12. Before any coping or foundations for monuments, slabs, etc. is placed, application must be made to the Manager, who shall approve the size, material and general design and location, and the Directors shall have the right to remove any coping, foundations, etc. which has not been so approved.

13. No double burials (that is, one body being placed above another) will be allowed, unless special permission be granted by the Manager.
