

8. The general nature of the business for which the corporation is organized is (it is not necessary to set forth in the purposes powers enumerated in Section 2.2) (12—12.2 Supplemental Code 1962)

To buy, sell and exchange property, real or personal, and expressly including all types of material handling equipment, both directly and as agent or broker, and to perform all acts necessary to accomplish any and all of the purposes for which the corporation is organized.
