e receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto William R. Wyatt, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot #128 of a subdivision of the property of P. R. Long and Walter Goldsmith as shown on plat thereof prepared by Dalton & Neves, May 1944, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book O, at Page 11 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Temple Street (formerly Mauldin Street) at the corner of its intersection with a 16-foot alley and running thence along the line of said alley, N. 2-45 W. 83.9 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot #123; thence along the line of Lot #123, S. 87-15 W. 37.5 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots #127 and #128; thence along line of Lot #127, S. 2-45 E. 97.6 feet to an iron pin on Temple Street; thence along said Temple Street, N. 67-04 E. 40 📉 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to the granting corporation by Arthur J. McKinney by deed ated August 23, 1962 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 705 at Page 255.

All of that lot of land in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being located on the west side of Pine Street and being bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point which is 128.8 feet from the northwestern intersection of Taylor Street and Pine Street, and running thence along the western edge of Pine Street, N. 3-30 W. 44 feet to an iron pin; thence leaving Pine Street and running thence S. 87-15 W. 57.5 feet to an iron pin; thence running on a line between the property formerly of Minnie A. Patterson and Lillie B. Scott, S. 2-45 E. 44 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 87-15 E. 58.5 feet to the beginning corner.
