KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, WILLIAM R. TIMMONS, JR.

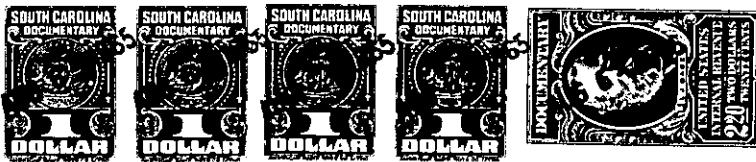
in consideration of ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100-----(\$1,750.00)----- Dollars,
