KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT BURLINGTON INDUSTRIES, INC., a Delaware corporation, with executive offices in Greensboro, Guilford County, North Carolina, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred and Four Dollars (\$2,204.00) to it paid by W. ROY ELLISON, JR. and wife, CAMILLE S. ELLISON, in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. ROY ELLISON, JR. and wife, CAMILLE S. ELLISON, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being at the intersection of Sandown Lane (formerly Cora Lane) and Rollingreen Road, near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 34 on plat of Addition to Wellington Green as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book RR, Page 99, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Westerly side of Sandown Lane, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots 34 and 99, and running thence with the common line of said Lots N 81-50 W 180.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N 30-44 E 195 feet to an iron pin on the Southwesterly side of Rollingreen Road; thence with the Southwesterly side of Rollingreen Road S 59-42 E 82.1 feet to an iron pin; thence on a curve, the chord of which is S 32-38 E 42.1 feet to an iron pin on the Westerly side of Sandown Lane; thence with the Westerly side of Sandown Lane S 5-34 W 115 feet to an iron pin, the point of BEGINNING.
