in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto said T. D. Saunders and Jeanne R. Saunders

for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them, his or her heirs and assigns, forever, in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of

reversion, the following described property, to-wit: All that lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the Town of Mauldin, being a portion of the property shown on a plat of T. D. Cooper property, recorded in Plat Book DD at Page 37, and being more particularly described according to a plat of the Property of James K. Cole by Jones Engeineering Services dated November 9, 1965, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern edge of Owens Lane on the line of Peachtree Terrace, Section 1 (Plat EE page 189) and running thence along said Lane, N. 52-25 E. 211.8 feet to point in a culvert near the center of said Lane; thence up the branch which passes through said culvert as the line, traverse line being N. 60-15 W. 312.5 feet to a large Blackgum (said Blackgum being 19 feet S. 34-27 W. from said creek;)thence N. 34-27 E. 113 feet (from said Blackgum) to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 11 as shown on a plat recorded in Plat Book M at page 135; thence along said Lot 11, N. 44-38 W. 199.4 feet to the rear corner of L. A. Kellett; thence along the Kellett lot, S. 29-09 W. 290 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Peachtree Terrace, S. 49 E. 413 feet to the point of beginning. This is the identical property conveyed to the Grantor by deed of W. L. Nelson recorded in Deed Book 500 at page 137 and it is the Grantor's intent that all property acquired by the aforesaid deed shall be conveyed hereunder despite any differences in description.
