in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William M. Elmore, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville ~~Township~~, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. situate on the southern side of East Washington Street, being shown on plat prepared by Pickell and Pickell dated October 1, 1947, recorded in Plat Book U at page 135, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of East Washington Street at the northeastern corner of property now or formerly owned by Farnsworth, and running thence along Farnsworth line, S. 19-33 E. 273.3 feet to an iron pin on the northern edge of the right-of-way of the C & WC Railway; thence along the northern edge of the said right-of-way, N. 54-13 E. 91.3 feet to an iron pin at the southwestern corner of Crymes property; thence along Crymes line, N. 23-08 W. 249.6 feet to a point in a driveway on the southern side of East Washington Street; thence along the southern side of East Washington Street, S. 69-25 W. 72 feet to the point of beginning.
