

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the Southern side of the Stauton Bridge Road, in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds to wit, according to a survey by H. S. Brockman, dated March 21, 1946: -

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of said Stauton Bridge Road, at corner of property now or formerly owned by Mrs. Martha G. Palmer, and running thence along line of said Palmer property S. 37-45 E. 438 feet, more or less, to a point; thence continuing with said Palmer property S. 47-15 W. 516 feet, more or less, to a point; thence continuing with said Palmer property S. 32-02 E. 624 feet, more or less, to a point; thence S. 23 - 45 W. 334.5 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence N. 32-02 W., along adjoining property line, 1,294 feet, more or less, to a point on the southern side of the said Stauton Bridge Road; thence along the southern side of said Stauton Bridge Road, in a northeasternly direction, 715 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, and containing 12.45 acres, more or less, and being a portion of the property conveyed by J. H. White to J. F. White, in 1941, by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County in Deed Book 232 at page 134.

The aforesaid J. F. White, now deceased, executed his last will and testament under date of May 12, 1955, on file in the Office of the Greenville County Probate Court in file 13, Apartment 714, whereby he devised a one-half undivided interest in and to said property to his wife, Sadie White, and a one-fourth undivided interest therein to his son, J. Herbert White, and a one-fourth undivided interest therein to his daughter, Vada Bell White Heath. The aforesaid Sadie White died intestate on or about the 2nd day of July, 1962, still the owner of her said interest in and to said property, and the said J. Herbert White and the said Vada Bell White Heath were her sole heirs at law and sole distributees, and all debts and obligations whatsoever of the said Sadie White and of her estate have been paid in full.

The grantee herein promises and agrees to pay all of the property taxes on said property for all of the calendar year 1966. All of said property taxes for 1965 and prior years have been paid, and said property is clear of all liens and encumbrances, and this deed conveys to the grantee herein a good, fee simple, marketable title to said property, clear and free of all liens and encumbrances.
