Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, upon receipt of \$3,333.34

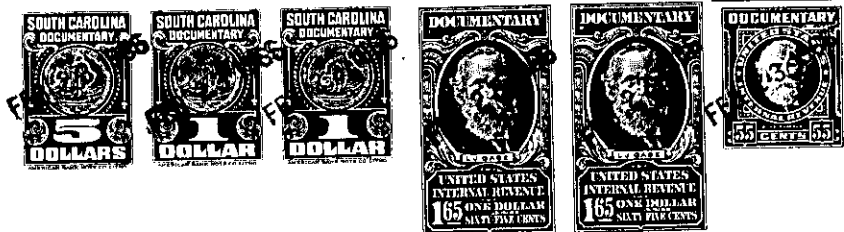
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto
the said Lewis E. Bramlett

"ALL that undivided one-third interest of the said Hylan Elizabeth
Adams and Elizabeth C. Adams in and to:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of
South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville,
on the western side of Butler Avenue, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Butler Avenue, and running thence with
the western side of said Avenue N. 19-30 E. 54 feet to corner of lot
formerly owned by Jane E. Wallace; thence S. 65 E. 212 3/4 feet to
corner of lot formerly owned by J.T. Bramlett; thence S. 26-30 W.
52.5 feet to stake; thence N. 65 W. 206.2 feet to the beginning corner.
