Rabb, Jr., and Janet McPherson Rabb, an undivided one-eighth (1/8) in-  
terest each, of, in and to the following described property:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, Green-  
ville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the south side of South Main Street, 117 feet  
7 inches southward from the southwest corner of Main and Broad Streets,  
and running thence southward along said Main Street 62 feet to an iron  
pin on the northeast corner of lot formerly owned by R. N. and J. D.
