Riddle March 22, 1939, and recorded in Volume J at Page 59, and more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northeast corner of the old Rutherford Road and Piedmont Avenue, and running thence with Piedmont Avenue S. 76-45 E. 194 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-55 E. 108.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 76-45 E. 197 feet to an iron pin on old Rutherford Road; thence with the Old Rutherford Road S. 31-55 W. 108 feet to the point of beginning. The discrepancy in the above description from the original plat is caused by the widening of the road.

This is the same premises conveyed to the grantor and Wilma Aleen Howard (later Wilma Howard Burns) by deed of J. M. Howard dated February 12, 1943 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 251, Page 124, the one-half undivided interest of the said Wilma Howard Burns being subsequently deeded to the grantor herein by deed dated January 13, 1955, which deed is recorded in Volume 516, Page 168.
