and attached garages. A garage may be constructed separately from the residence for the convenience of not more than two automobiles. No exterior walls for residences or garages shall be of concrete or cinder blocks unless faces with brick or stucco. No metal or tin roofs shall be permitted on any building.

- 5. No building shall be removed from any other property and relocated on any one of the lots shown on plat, and no dwelling commonly known as a "shell house" shall be located on any of the lots. Further, no trailer, tent, shack, barn or other building lots. Further any lot shall be used as a temporary or permanent residence.
- 6. No fences or other obstruction exceeding 3.5 feet in height shall be erected between the street line and front line of any residence.
- activity
  No obnoxious or offensive/shall be carried on upon any lot which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance in the neighborhood.
- No horses, cows, hogs or fowl shall be allowed on the premises.
- All sewage disposal shall be by septic tank meeting the requirements of the public health authorities or by public sewer when and where available.

On Lot No. 25 as shown on said plat there is presently located a residence, the same being the old Holliday home. The foregoing covenants and restrictions do not apply to Lot No. 25, as to present residence and its location, but in all other respects these covenants and restrictions do apply, and if the residence should be removed at any time in the future, all of these restrictions shall apply to any new constructions to be located on the lot.
