ALL water lines, mains, valves, sleeves, hydrants, and appurtenances installed and located in, under or along Hill Street and Mill Street, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being 1800' of 2" Galv. Pipe, 995' of 6" C.I. Pipe, 4 - 2" Valves, 4 - 6" Valves, 1 - 8" x 6" Tapping Sleeve and 1 - 6" Tapping Valve, all as shown on drawing entitled "W.N. Leslie, Inc. to City of Greenville", attached hereto and made a part of this conveyance.

ALSO:

ALL water lines, mains, valves, sleeves, hydrants, and appurtenances installed and located in, under or along Pryor Road, Drewry Road and crossing Taylors Road, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being 418' of 2" Galv. Pipe, 897' of 6" C. I. Pipe, 2 - 2" Valves, 1 - 6" Valves, 1 - 6" x 6" Tapping Sleeve, 1 - 6" Tapping Valve, and 1 - Fire Hydrant, all as shown on drawing entitled "Williams Land Co. to City of Greenville," attached hereto and made a part of this conveyance.

TOGETHER with all pipe, valves and other mechanical parts and equipment appurtenant to said main and lines and all rights of way and easements necessary or incident to the operation, maintenance, repair or replacement of said water main, pipe lines and appurtenant equipment.
