County State of South Carolina about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles from Greenville Court House, North of Cedar Lane Road or Main Street on the West side of River Street (now known as Pickens Street) and being known and designated as LOT No. 1 as shown on plat of property of B. H. Trammell according to survey made by J. C.Hill, May 31, 1950 and having the following metes and bounds:
BEGINNING at an iron pin on River Street (now Pickens Street) joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2 and running thence N. 80-30 West 210 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 90-45 W.70 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 80-30 E. 210 feet to an ironpin on River Street (now Pickens Street); running thence along River Street (now Pickens Street) N. 90-45 E. 70 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
