in consideration of the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY & No/100 (\$750.00) in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

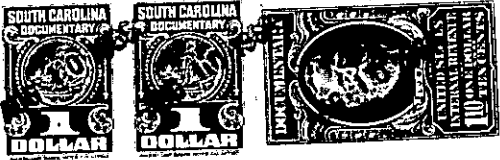

Pitman and Harriette Pitman, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Bates Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and described as the Southern one-half (1/2) of Lot No. 4 on Plat of property of Homer Styles, recorded in Plat Book YY, at Page 101, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Gaston Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4 and running thence with the line of said lots, S. 65-55 W. 320.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 45-36 W. 53.7 feet, more or less, to a point in the middle of the rear line of Lot No. 4 as originally laid out and shown on said Plat; thence N. 65-55 E. 340.6 feet, more or less, to a point on the Western side of Gaston Drive, which point is in the middle of said lot as originally laid out and shown on said Plat; thence with the Western side of Gaston Drive S. 24-05 E. 50 feet to the point of beginning; being a portion of that lot conveyed to the grantors by deed recorded in Deed Book 762, at Page 85.
